DX Code of Conduct

As a reference for myself, and for all those engaged in amateur radio, here is a copy of the DX code of conduct. You are encouraged to copy it wherever you like. To make things clearer, I numbered each rule of conduct and highlighted the most important parts.

- 1. I will listen, and listen, and then listen agai before calling.
- 2. I will only call, if I can copy the DX statio properly.
- 3. I will not trust the DX cluster and will be sure (the DX station's call sign before calling.
- 4. I will not interfere with the DX station nc anyone calling and will never tune up on the D frequency or in the QSX slot.
- 5. I will wait for the DX station to end a contac before I call.
- 6. I will always send my full call sign.
- 7. I will call and then listen for a reasonabl interval. I will not call continuously.
- 8. I will not transmit when the DX operator call another call sign, not mine.
- 9. I will not transmit when the DX operator querie a call sign not like mine.
- 10. I will not transmit when the DX station request geographic areas other than mine.
- 11. When the DX operator calls me, I will not repeating my call sign unless I think he has copied incorrectly.
- 12. I will be thankful if and when I do mak a contact.
- 13. I will respect my fellow hams and conduct myself so as to earn their respect.

There is also an expanded version in English, containing many useful hints.
